

OUR MISSION

We, the members of the Potter Valley Tribe, pusuant to our inherent sovereignty as a nation, do hereby adopt and establish this Constitution for the purposes of providing for the health, safety, and welfare of our people, to promote our economy, to preserve, protect, and pass on our culture to future generations, to maintain community harmony, to achieve fairness and justice, to honor our traditions, our ancestors, and our elders, to assert and exercise our sovereignty, to affirm and build natural resources of our aboriginal land or any other acquired territory, to carry on enterprises for the benefit of our community, and to establish duties and rights of the citizens fo the Potter Valley Tribe living on or off-reservation.






ANCESTRAL RANGE OF POTTER VALLEY TRIBE PROBABLE AREA OF TRAILS TO EAST AND WEST

Potter Valley Tribe – Tribal Environmental Office

- Management of grant projects and hosting of annual Inter-Tribal Campout
- Forestry Management Planning and Wildfire Mitigation Projects
- BioChar Study and demonstration project quantifying climate benefits
- Stewardship of Trout/Alder Creek properties with Mendocino Land Trust
- Wildfire prevention thinning of previously cut regrowth conifers
- Patrols of properties to prevent dumping & monitoring storm damage
- Improvement of well on Eel 14 shoreline for groundwater monitoring
- Clean Water Act surface water monitoring program funded by US EPA
- Over a decade of assisting with hosting of Annual Eel River Clean-ups
